

DIY BEESWAX WRAPS



A waxing bar covers one large beeswax wrap approximately 13"x14" inches. For more coverage wax twice.

Ingredients: Sustainably sourced Pine Resin, Jojoba Oil & Beeswax.

You will Need:

- Oven.
- Recycled baking sheet or disposable tray.

Note: Always read instructions before use. Requires adult supervision for children under the age of 14 due to handling of hot ingredients. We recommend using recycled equipment whenever possible. Making beeswax wraps is sticky business!

- Preheat the oven to 200 degrees or less.
- Place a premixed waxing bar on a baking sheet lined with parchment paper.
- Insert in oven, keeping door slightly open to allow air to circulate.
- When the waxing bar is completely melted remove from oven.
- Place fabric on baking sheet and brush mixture into fabric.
- Return to oven and bake 1-2 minutes until liquified.
- Remove from oven and place wrap on a hanger or string line to dry.
- Attach reusable button to the corner of the wrap and tie the end of hemp string to the front of button to convert into a sandwich wrap.

Beeswax Care Instructions:

Gently wash by hand in cold water with mild dish soap, rinse & dry over dish rack. Typically lasts 9-12 months depending on usage. You can refresh the wrap again by repeating the steps above.

Note: This product contains pine resin, so it may not be suitable for those who have pine allergies.

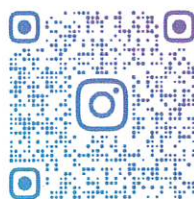
